
- Easily merge multiple TEXT files into a single PDF.

STEPS FOR CONVERTING TEXT TO PDF

1. <u>Download and install a free trial</u> to try it out or <u>install and activate your pur</u>chased copy.

As a virtual printer, PDF Creator Plus can create PDF files by simply printing to PDF Creator Plus instead of your regular printer.


Combining the virtual printer with the **PDF Creator Plus app** allows you to convert to PDF from a single document or many different documents from different applications.





2. Open your TXT document and then select File -> Print from the application menu. Text documents are commonly opened with Notepad, WordPad, or Microsoft Word.

3. Choose **PDF Creator Plus 8** from the list of printers then click the **Print** button.

4. PDF Creator Plus will display the printed pages from your TEXT file. Click the **Create PDF** button to convert your TEXT to PDF now or continue printing TEXT or other files to the **PDF Creator Plus 8** printer to add more pages.







- **5.** In the **Create File** dialog, type in a name for your new PDF document and choose where to save it. Next, set your options for creating a PDF file:
 - a. Select **PDF file(*.pdf)** as the Save as type
 - b. Check the **Multipage PDF**, and **Embed fonts** options.
 - c. If you added <u>hyperlinks</u> or <u>outline information</u> annotations by hand, check the options for **Create hyperlinks**, **Create outlines**, or both.
 - d. Check the **Open file** option to open your PDF automatically upon creation.
 - e. Lastly, click the **Save** button to convert your TEXT to PDF.
- **6.** A progress dialog will appear as PDF Creator Plus creates your new PDF. If you need to change your PDF, use the *Cancel* button to stop the process. You can then make your changes and start again.
