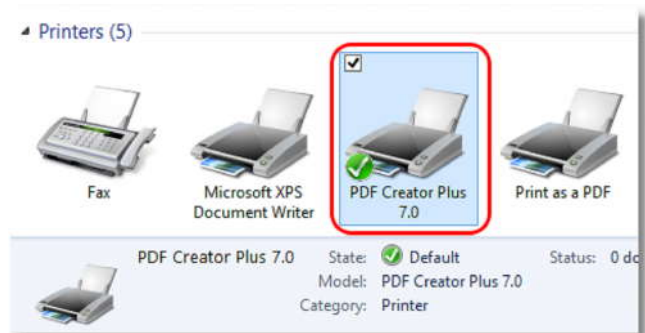

WHY CONVERT TO PDF WITH PDF CREATOR PLUS?

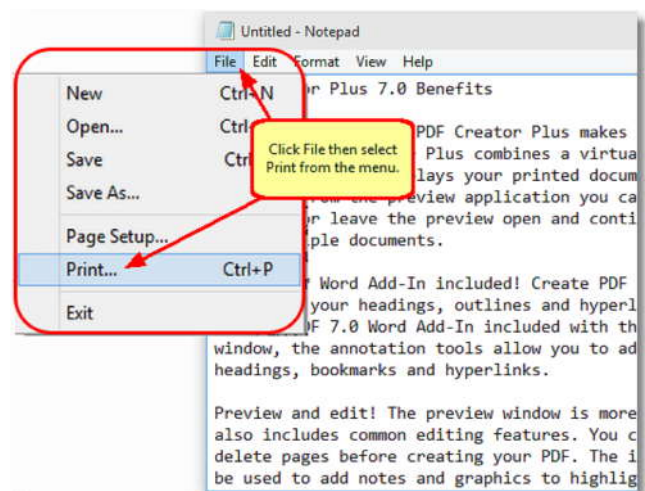
- Convert Word, Excel, Photoshop and other files to PDF documents just by printing
- Easily combine multiple documents into a single PDF using the PDF preview window
- Add, move and delete unwanted pages before creating your PDF to get the exact PDF you want
- Use the included annotation features to add notes, graphics, and hyperlinks to your PDF
- More than just PDF, PDF Creator Plus can also create TIFF, JPEG and BMP images

STEPS FOR CONVERTING TO PDF

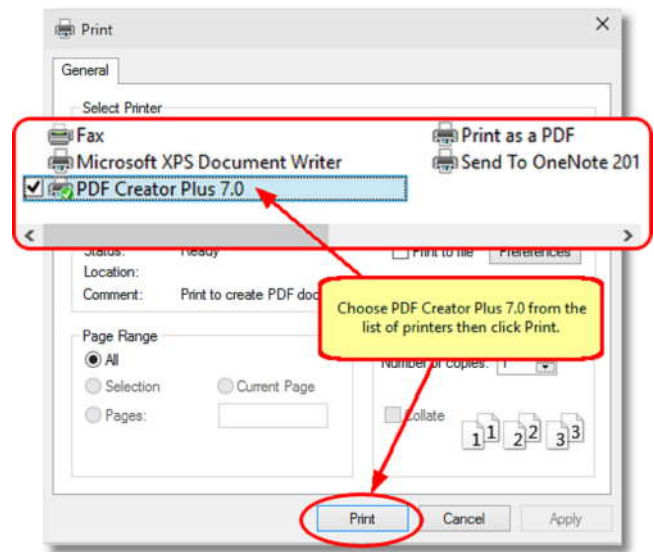
1. **Download your free trial** and install **PDF Creator Plus** on your computer. As a virtual printer, PDF Creator Plus can create PDF files by simply printing to **PDF Creator Plus** instead of your normal printer.



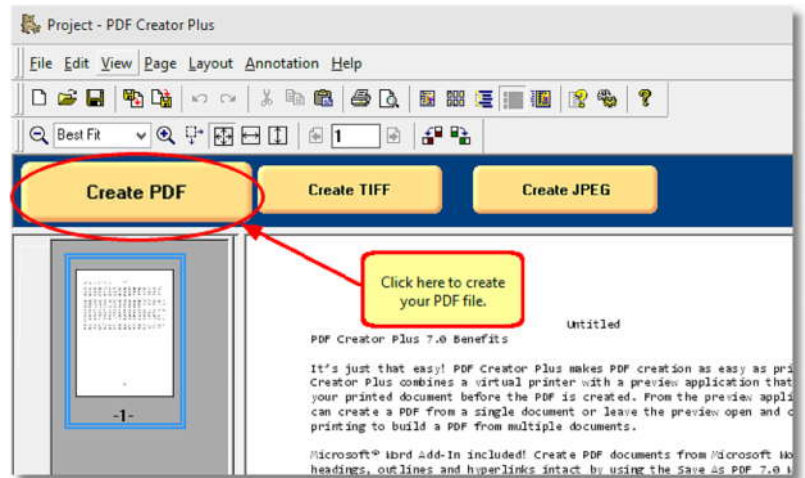
2. Open your document in its native application, such as Notepad for a text file and select **File->Print** from the application menu.



3. Choose **PDF Creator Plus 7.0** from the list of printers then click the **Print** button.

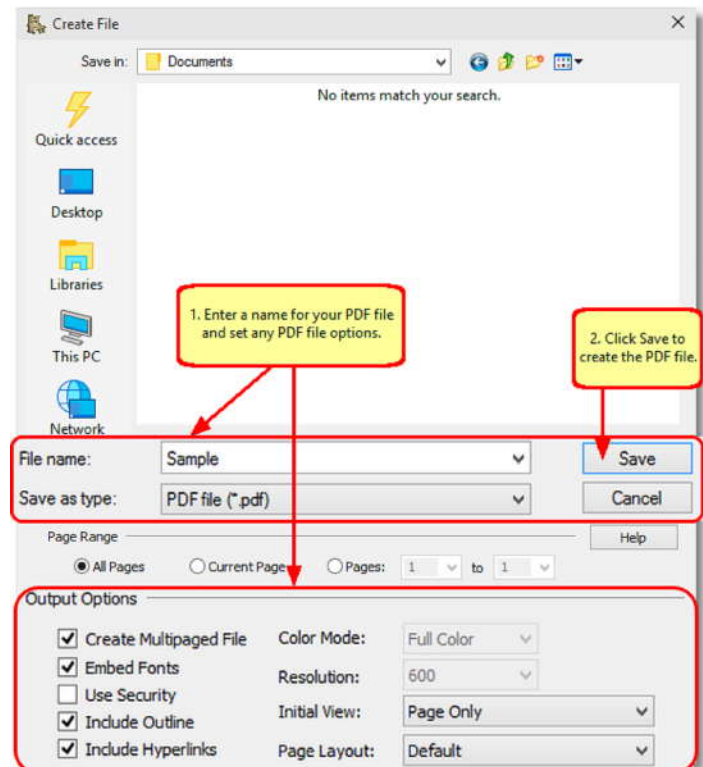


4. PDF Creator Plus will display the printed pages from your document. You can add more pages by printing more files to the PDF Creator Plus 7.0 printer. When all pages have been added, click on the **Create PDF** button to convert to PDF.



5. In the **Create File** dialog:

- Type in a name for your new PDF document and choose where to save it.
- Select **PDF file (*.pdf)** as the Save as type and ensure the **Create Multipaged File, Embed Fonts, Include Outline** and **Include Hyperlinks** options are checked.
- Click the **Save** button to convert the pages to a single PDF file.



6. A progress dialog is displayed while your PDF is being created.
