PDF CREATOR PLUS FEATURE HIGHLIGHTS

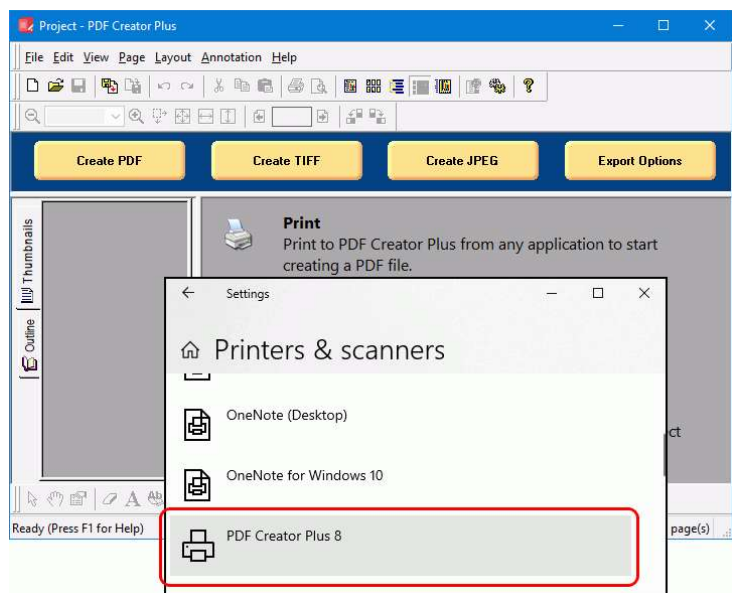
- Easily merge multiple RTF files into a single PDF.
- [Drag and drop PDF files](#) to quickly add your RTF file to an existing PDF file.
- Preview, add, organize, and delete unwanted pages before creating your PDF.
- More than just PDF, [PDF Creator Plus can also create TIFF](#), JPEG, and BMP images

STEPS FOR CONVERTING RTF TO PDF

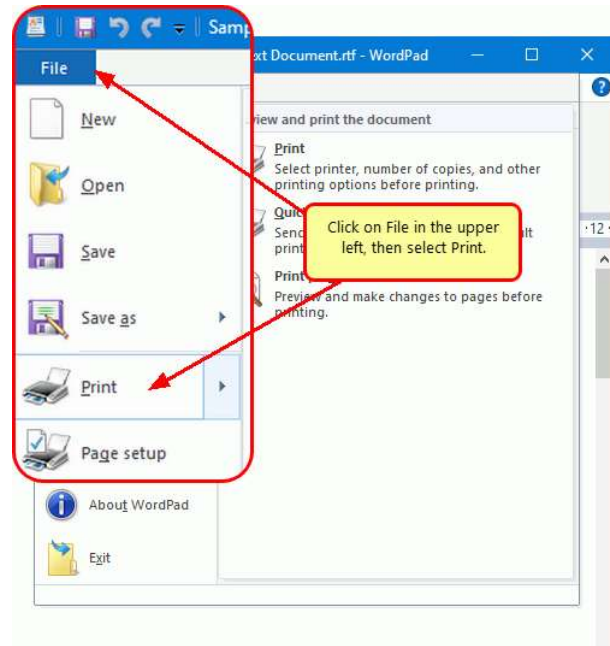
1. [Download and install a free trial](#) to try it out, or [install and activate your purchased copy](#). The setup program will install the **PDF Creator Plus app** and **PDF Creator Plus 8 virtual printer** to your computer.

PDF Creator Plus converts files to PDF by printing any file to the [PDF Creator Plus 8](#) printer instead of your regular printer.

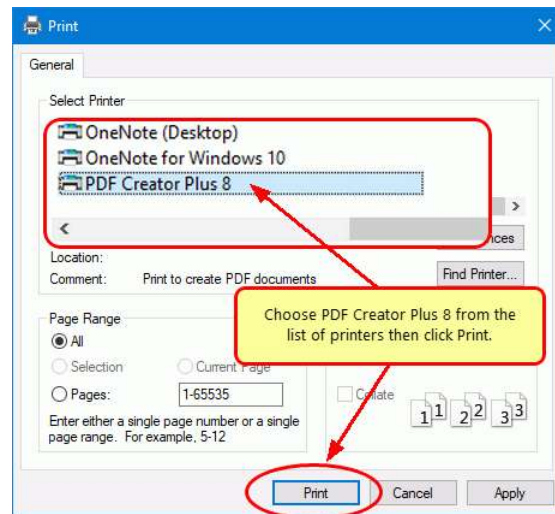
Combining the virtual printer with the **PDF Creator Plus PDF** allows you to convert to PDF from a single document or many different documents from different applications.



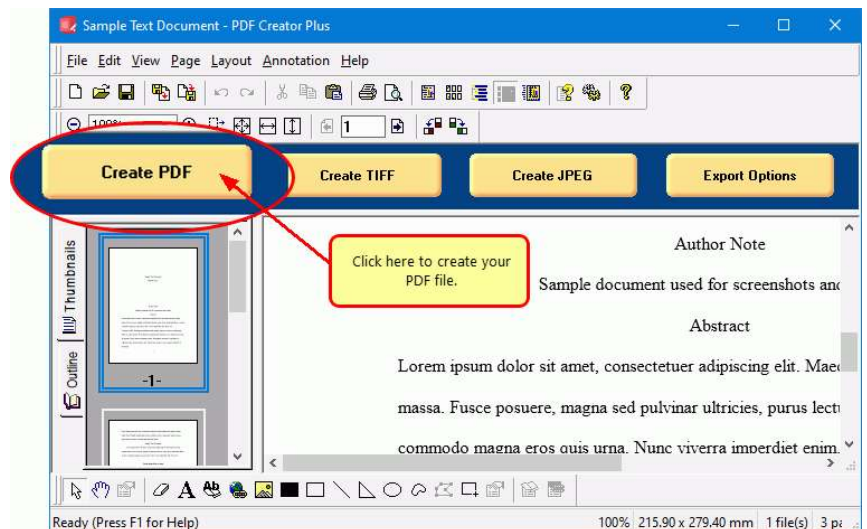
2. Open your RTF document and then select **File -> Print** from the application menu. RTF documents are commonly opened with *WordPad* or *Microsoft Word*.



3. Choose **PDF Creator Plus 8** from the list of printers then click the **Print** button.

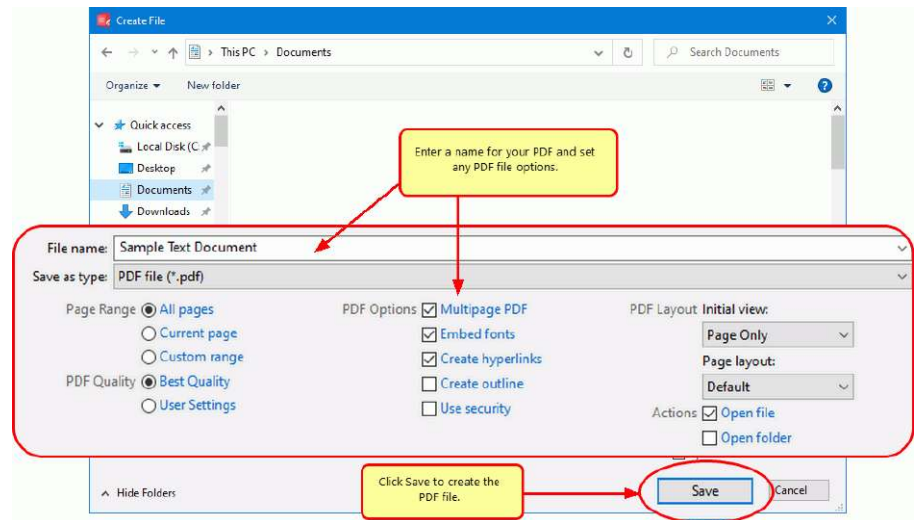


4. PDF Creator Plus will display the printed pages from your RTF file. Click the **Create PDF** button to convert your RTF to PDF now or continue printing RTF or other files to the **PDF Creator Plus 8** printer to add more pages.



5. In the **Create File** dialog, type in a name for your new PDF document and choose where to save it, then:

- a. Select **PDF file (*.pdf)** as the *Save as type*
- b. Check the **Multipage PDF**, and **Embed fonts** options.
- c. If you added [hyperlinks](#) or [outline information](#) annotations by hand, check the options for **Create hyperlinks**, **Create out-lines**, or both.
- d. Check the **Open file** option to open your PDF automatically upon creation.
- e. Lastly, click the **Save** button to convert your RTF to PDF.



6. A progress dialog will appear as PDF Creator Plus creates your new PDF. If you need to change your PDF, use the *Cancel* button to stop the process. You can then make your changes and start again.
